UMKC IACUC POLICY

Animal Transportation

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Policy is to define the standards for transportation of animals.

Policy

All animals will be transported in a manner that applies to requirements set by the USDA and guidelines in the *Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals* and follow the SOPs of the LARC "LARC-03 - Animal Transportation".

Applicable To:

All UMKC faculty, staff, employees, and students involved in the care or use of animals owned by the UMKC.

Procedures:

For transport within UMKC:

- 1. Animals will be transported in cages/containers that provide adequate space to allow animals to exhibit movement typical for the species.
- 2. Animals will be transported in secure cages/containers to prevent escape during transport.
- Animals will be transported in cages/containers that will prevent injury to animals
- 4. Animals will not be exposed to environmental extremes during transport.
- 5. Cages/containers will be covered to reduce stress to the animal(s), prevent public exposure to animal allergens, and prevent exposure of the animals to public view.
- 6. In case of an accident during transport, the health and welfare of the animals should be assessed and if possible, proceed with them to their desired destination.
- 7. Loss or injury of animals during transport within UMKC facilities should be immediately reported to the LARC director and the attending veterinarian.
- 8. Animal transport by bus, taxi, bike, scooter, or any other mode of public transport or ride-sharing services is prohibited.
- 9. Personal vehicle usage for the transport of animals on campus is discouraged, as it presents a risk of contamination due to biosecurity, allergens, zoonotic disease, and an increased risk of animal loss or injury. If personal vehicular transport within UMKC is unavoidable investigators must specify a plan in the animal protocol form and be approved by the IACUC. UMKC is not responsible for damage to personal vehicles damaged during animal transport.

For transport outside UMKC:

Refer to SOP LARC-03.

Revisions to the Policy:

This policy is intended to be flexible and readily adaptable to changes in regulatory requirements. The UMKC IACUC has the authority to amend this policy.
